5. Report on the Registration of AIGC

HRH Zolani Mkiva presented a detailed report that confirmed the successful registration of AIGC as a Non-Profit Organization (NPO) with the provision of the South African legal jurisdiction. The only outstanding issue is the ratification of the Directors/Board Members owing to their submission of the certified copies of their Identity Documents or Passports and their residential addresses.

6. Report on the opening of the Bank Account

HRH Zolani Mkiva gave the meeting a feedback on the opening of the Bank Account for AIGC. He informed the members that the Bank Account has been opened with the First National Bank (FNB) and the type of account is a Cheque Business Account. The initial signatories of the Bank Account are HRH Zolani Mkiva and Prince Manene Tabane.

8. Acceptance Speech by the newly elected AIGC President

In his acceptance speech, the President on behalf of the newly elected Executive Members thanked Princess Kongo for the good job done during the Transitional period and praised her other Executive members as well for the sacrifices made. He further expressed his gratitude for the confidence bestowed on him and his team and underlined the need for a team spirit and approach to issues and the necessity for speed, accuracy, integrity and loyalty to Africa as we all should hit the ground running. This MUST stop and it is on us its children to launch the assault to win back the sovereignty and respect lost this far. We cannot continue to be mocked at as poor in the midst of abundance and by the same people who conspire in plundering our God-given resources. Political and Traditional Leaders must forge a relationship that makes 'The Africa We Want' far from being a dream by 2063, AU standards. We must seek to glorify Africa with the Traditional and Customary means at our disposal and we can only do so with a single loud voice.
